Maria-Sophia Pera


Originally from Ottawa, Maria-Sophia Pera is currently studying in Montreal, where she obtained her Bachelor in Violin Performance at the University of Montreal. She has also participated in the Kronberg Academy, Orford Musique, and Orpheus (Vienna) summer festivals, during which she worked with Professors Michael Frischenschlager and Mauricio Fuks. This year, Maria-Sophia completed her Masters degree at McGill's Schulich School of Music. As a member of Professor Violaine Melançon's studio, she will remain at McGill to complete the Graduate Diploma in Performance. Looking forward, Ms. Pera plans to continue preparing for competitions. In May 2021, she received the 3rd prize in the Concerto category of the Festival-Concours de musique de Sherbrooke. Previously, she has participated in the finals of the Marta Hidy competition in Toronto and she received 1st place in her category at the Canadian Music Competition.

Kevin Chen began his piano studies at the age of five and was admitted to Marlene Finn's piano class at the Conservatory of Music of Quebec in Gatineau in 2012, at the age of eight. National finalist several times at the Canadian Music Competition and winner of numerous awards at the Kiwanis Music Festival in Ottawa, he also won the first prize as well as the public prize in the junior category of the Thousand Islands International Piano Competition in New York in 2019. In 2021, he was the recipient of a scholarship from the Grande Finale Desjardins of the Festival-Concours de Musique Classique in Sorel-Tracy as the first-prize winner of the 17 years old and under category.

At the Conservatory, Kevin won the Bravissimo competition twice, the 2017 CMG Concerto Competition as well as the 2020 OSG Concerto Competition, subsequently performing Edvard Grieg's Concerto with the Conservatory Symphony Orchestra and Ludwig van Beethoven's Concerto No.3 with the Gatineau Symphony Orchestra. In 2015, he performed with the well-known pianist Lang Lang at the National Arts Center. He also took part in TV shows such as Virtuose from Radio-Canada and La Fabrique culturelle from Télé-Québec.

Kevin often performs as a soloist, chamber musician and accompanist at the Conservatory as well as part of the Young String Performers' Foundation series. He has worked with many professors such as André Laplante, David Jalbert, Denise Trudel, Hugues Cloutier, Michel Fournier, Pierre-Richard Aubin, Richard Raymond, Suzanne Beaubien and Suzanne Goyette. Kevin is currently studying to obtain a double DEC in music and science.
